(Continued from Page One) and that they either are unable to contact anyone here, or have undisclosed reasons for failure to disclose their whereabouts.

Unpaid Balance
There was a considerable unpaid balance due on a diamond ring purchased by Mrs. Patterson. She did not pay anything on the account after she and her husband disappeared March 6.

That is a significant development in the affairs of the Pattersons. Their credit rating is like "a United States bond," according to El Paso credit authorities. They had credit virtually unlimited, and paid accounts with exacting promptness.

Yet, after they disappeared the diamond ring account fell in arrears for months. There was no word from the Pattersons.

So far as has been made public, not one word has come back from the Pattersons saying they intend to return to El Paso in December or at any other time.

Telegram Sent
A telegram supposedly sent from Dallas by Mr. Patterson March 15, nine days after their mysterious disappearance, gave instructions on operation of the Patterson Photo Supply store, and said to rent the Patterson home at 3000 Piedmont avenue for nine months. The house was rented in July until Dec. 15.

The only official lookout issued on the Pattersons is a missing persons all-points bulletin broadcast in August by Sheriff Jimmie Hicks. That failed to bring any trace of the Pattersons — theirs being a cold trail dating back five months before the missing persons bulletin.

Justice of the Peace Texas S. Ward has indicated he will order a court of inquiry into the Patterson case if he obtains sufficient information to give him "reason to believe a crime has been committed."

Congress Probes "Talent Waste"

WASHINGTON, Oct. 4. — Congress opened an investigation today into charges that the government is wasting scientific manpower at a time when Russia is making rapid technological progress.

The House Manpower Subcommittee called Defense Department manpower officials to testify at an afternoon hearing on the "talent waste" charges. The subcommittee's inquiry was the first to be held by Congress on an outgrowth of Russia's latest advances in the missile and space satellite fields.

Juarez Unions Pick Candidate

Mexico's national election campaign was opened in Juarez today with endorsement by the CROC labor federation of Adolfo Lopez Mateos for president of Mexico.

The Juarez endorsement coincided with reports from Mexico City that Lopez Mateos is favored by numerous groups as nominee of the dominant political party, PRI, to succeed President Adolfo Ruiz Cortines.

Lopez Mateos is minister of labor in the Ruiz Cortines cabinet. President Ruiz Cortines' term expires in December of 1958. He is not eligible to succeed himself. The presidential term is for six years.

Amendment Three provides authority for the state to issue \$200 million in bonds to be used in assisting local government subdivisions in water conservation.
